
Southampton General Hospital travel directions



By Car

From the M3, follow signs for Southampton A33 (not Southampton Docks). Leave the roundabout onto A33 Bassett Avenue follow the A33 through two roundabouts. Leave the second roundabout onto A35 Winchester Road. Turn right onto Dale Road and then turn right onto Tremona Road.

From the M27 travelling from the east, take Junction 5 (Southampton Airport/Eastleigh) and take the first exit off the roundabout. At the third set of lights, the road divides. Turn right onto Burgess Road (McDonald's will be on your left). The University's Highfield campus is about 3/4 of a mile ahead on your left. Follow Burgess Road passing Boldrewood Campus on your right. At the major intersection with The Avenue, continue straight on along Burgess Road. Turn right at the mini-roundabout and immediately left into the filter lane onto Winchester Road. Turn right onto Dale Road and then turn right onto Tremona Road.

From the M27 travelling from the west, take Junction 3 and follow signs for M271 City Centre and The Docks. At Redbridge roundabout turn left onto A35 Redbridge Road. Stay in the left-hand lane to the next roundabout and take the second exit into Teboura Way following the signs for the A35 and University of Southampton. Continue along Teboura Way through three sets of light onto Winchester Road. Turn right onto Dale Road and then turn right onto Tremona Road.

The entrance to the site's main parking in the multi-storey carpark is off Tremona Road at the northern end of the site. At certain times of day there is a long queue for this car park. If so, leave the queue, and carry on to the exit to Coxford Road and turn left. Re-enter the hospital grounds via the entrance on your left a little further down Coxford Road. Turn right at the T-junction and follow the hospital perimeter road at the southern end of the site until you find the car park for the Eye Unit and Neurological Centre. This car park usually has spaces.

Disabled parking is along the front by the main entrance, with access via Tremona Road. Extra disabled parking is available at the southern end of the site, on the roadway near the entrance to the Eye Unit and by the Neurological Centre, with access for all these areas from Coxford Road.

Fast services from London and Bournemouth/Weymouth serve Southampton Central and Southampton Airport. When alighting at Southampton Central, head for Platform 4, and the exit marked Uni-link Buses. Turn left and walk about 10 minutes up the hill towards the Civic Centre Clock Tower. Cross over the road to the Civic Centre where you will see the Uni-link bus stop for the U6 (for Southampton General Hospital).

Taxi ranks are outside both Platform I and Platform 4 station exits and a fare to Southampton General Hospital costs under £10.

By Bus

The following First Southampton bus services serve the hospital: 6 or 6a from Burgess Road outside Boldrewood Campus and 10 or 10a from Southampton Central Station.
