## **Guidance on allocation of protected time for Foundation Pharmacists**

## Workplace supervised learning events

- Foundation pharmacists (FPs) will be given protected time to undertake supervised learning events with their practice supervisor.
- The allocation of protected time will vary dependent on Trust policy some Trusts will allocate set protected time each week during which time FPs are expected to organise and complete their supervised learning events; in others there is no ringfenced time but FPs should always be able to secure protected time for supervised learning events.

## Academic learning sets – preparation and attendance

- All Foundation Pharmacists (FPs) will be given study leave to attend HEI learning sets.
- If an FP is unable to attend their local/ normal learning set because the Trust has asked them to swap and attend on a different day, study leave will always be granted.
- If an FP is unable to attend their local/ normal learning set because they have requested leave on the normal learning set date, leave will be granted at the discretion of the Trust. Furthermore attendance at a different set must be agreed at least 2 weeks in advance by the learning set co-ordinator.
- If an FP needs to review a particular patient type in preparation for a learning set that they would not normally see as part of their day to day work, they should seek to share a patient with a colleague in the first instance.
- Reading should normally be done in Foundation Pharmacists own time
- Preparation for learning sets will normally take place in FPs own time. However if there is a need to review certain patient types or complete ward activities that are **NOT** part of a current rotation, sharing patients or being signposted by a colleague would be the normal alternative.
